WORKING METHODOLOGY



LEARNING THROUGH DOING AND THROUGH TEACHING
Participants develop and run workshops to “teach” others about different aspects of internationalisation of curriculum, which helps them to truly learn about these aspects themselves.



PEER-LEARNING
Participants work in small groups, Institutional Internationalisation Teams, on project-related tasks, give and receive peer feedback on their work.



STRUCTURED REFLECTION OR REFLECTIVE PRACTICE
Participants are invited to reflect on own behaviour, learning, next developmental steps.
